- Two-thirds of blind and visually impaired are women
- Three-quarters of visual impairment is preventable or correctable
- One-third of age-related macular disease and one-fifth of cataract may be due to smoking
- Eye diseases increase with age, and healthy lifestyles can prevent and slow agerelated eye disease

Worldwide



- Two-thirds of blind people worldwide are women and girls, four-fifths of blindness and visual impairment occurs in developing countries
- In many countries, men's access to eye health care is twice that of women
- Effective strategies can and do successfully address this gender inequity
